



clubgolf Player Pathway

Firstclubgolf: 6 sessions delivered in school as part of Primary 5 P.E. curriculum delivered by the class teacher or a school representative. Classes also receive a vist from East Lothian's Golf Development Officer.

Clubgolf Stage 1: 40 hours of introductory coaching ideally delivered over 2 seasons by PGA Level 1 Volunteer Coaches or PGA Pros/Assistant Pros. Covers putting, chipping, full swing and on course.

Clubgolf Stage 2: 25 hours of coaching delivered by a PGA Level 1 Advanced Coach or PGA Pros/Assistant Pro. Builds on the foundations of Level 1 and introduces ball shaping.

Stage 3: 120 hours of coaching ideally delivered over 2 seasons by PGA Professionals.

Stage 4 and 5: Selected for SGU Area Academy Coaching or National Coaching

The number of coaching hours at each stage is a rough guide and some players will need more or less hours at each level depending on their ability/commitment.

Coaching times and dates are set by the club to suit their schedules with coaching generally running between April and October.

Children pay on average £2.50 per hour to attend Stage 1 coaching sessions.
