

Disability Activity Programme (DAP)
Nomination Form

- This form is for pupils with a physical or learning disability.
- Physical disabilities can be minor and not necessarily obvious by wheelchairs or amputations. For instance, mild cerebral palsy can manifest itself as a slight limp.
- Visual impairment is considered a physical disability.
- Having an additional support need is not the same as having a disability.
- For the purposes of disability sport, pupils with learning *difficulties* such as dyslexia, Autism, ADHD, Aspergers Syndrome or behaviour issues are not classed as having a disability.
- Pupils with a learning disability such as Downs Syndrome are classed as having a disability in terms of disability sport.

Please nominate all pupils with a disability (as per the above guidance) even if they are highly competent in PE and extra curricular activities. If in any doubt as to whether or not the nature of the pupil’s condition falls into the definition of disability for the purposes of disability sport, please include the pupil.
