Job Title: Club and Community Basketball Coach

Summary

The Club and Community Basketball Coach will work with East Lothian Dragons Basketball Club.

The coach is responsible for the planning and implementation of coaching sessions in the club along with club out-reach community basketball programmes. The hours will be agreed with the successful candidate and we are keen to stress this will be flexible depending on the candidates needs.

Key Duties and Responsibilities

The main duties of the Club and Community Basketball Coach include, but are not limited to:

- Supporting the delivery of Youth Sections
 - o Jointly planning and delivering sessions with the club coaches with a focus on player development and improvement
- Working with partners (Active East Lothian etc.) to arrange out-reach community work and signposting participants to club sessions

General

- Providing regular reports and updates to assigned line manager
- Collecting any information or data requested by the line manager
- Communicate effectively with the line manager and local/national partners

Skills and Attributes Required

- A formal basketball coaching qualification is advantageous but is not essential at this stage as training opportunities will be identified
- Enthusiastic and inclusive approach to coaching basketball with an ability to cater young people of various levels and abilities
- Reliable and punctual at all times
- Excellent communication skills with the confidence and ability to give clear instructions
- A full and clean driving licence is advantageous but is not essential

- The coach will be directed to accredited coaching and additional qualifications and development opportunities
